"CLUB OF THE MONTH"

First club to be featured is the Griffin Bowls Club

"The Griffin Bowls Club, based in Harlow, Essex, has always been very forward thinking, aiming to offer bowls to all the members of our community.

We first gained Club Mark in 2015 which gave us the opportunity to bid for funding to get the equipment we needed to start introducing bowls to the younger generation. We began working with a local school and cub group in 2017

In 2019 we were approached by the local Alzheimer's Society and the Harlow Youth Group who were interested in the possibility of setting up bowling sessions for their members.

We began hosting a Monday afternoon session for people with dementia and a Saturday Club for the Youth Group. The young people who had learning/physical disabilities, ranged in age from 14 - 25 years. The clubs were run by a group of volunteers from our membership, several who are trained coaches. Some of these young bowlers were very good and they were invited to start playing in Griffin friendly matches. At this time our club was working closely with the Bowls Development Alliance in the Club Development Program. It was our contact with the BDA who recommended we try for the Disability Mark. The club was

A working party was set up to work on the Disability Mark alongside reapplying for Club Mark. I am pleased to say we achieved both these accreditations. Club Mark in February 2019, followed by the presentation of Disability Mark and Love Fisher Brown Award in March 2020.

keen to achieve this as we already had many of the required elements in place.

Being successful in obtaining these awards has opened further funding opportunities which has now culminated with us being able to upgrade our club house making it a welcoming venue offering "Bowls For All", and we are now looking forward to welcoming these groups back onto the green.
